The FILLMORE JAZZ FESTIVAL, a Two-Day Free Festival Celebrating Sounds of the City

The largest free jazz festival on the West Coast, **The Fillmore Jazz Festival**, returns to San Francisco the weekend of July 1-2, 2023.

Typically drawing more than 100,000 visitors over Independence Day weekend, the Festival blends art and soul in one of the most unique neighborhoods in San Francisco. From sun-up to sun-down, visitors groove to the sounds of live music from multiple stages over 8 blocks, browse fine arts and crafts, and enjoy gourmet food and beverages.
